DATA VALIDATION RESULTS FOR NKPI AND OSR REPORTS

Data reported from clinical information systems (December 2023)




Data validation of the National Key Performance Indicators (nKPIs) and the Online Services Report (OSR) was undertaken by Solving Health. Four clinical information systems were validated: Best Practice (BP), Communicare (Ccare), Medical Director (MD) and MMEx.

Data validation was undertaken for the nKPI report only in December 2023. Using a control data set, each component measure was checked against the expected value/s for that measure. Each system was scored according to the number of measures correctly reported. Where the reported measure did not match the expected value, a reason for the discrepancy was ascertained and is reflected in the notes below.

All clinical information systems passed validation with only minor qualifications. In the opinion of Solving Health, the data reported from these systems are correct and comparable.

The nKPI summary is based on the 21 indicators reported directly from the clinical information system.

Report returns correct values according to specification


Minor difference: Minor differences in reported values are observed, assessed as being of minimal significance

The OSR summary is based on three measures reported directly from the clinical information system.



All systems returned correct values for Episodes of Care and Client numbers.

Correct: Report returns correct values according to specification

Minor difference: Minor differences in reported values are observed, assessed as being of minimal significance

BP - Client contacts - Health professionals not recognised: Transport (2 Worker Types), Medical Specialists (11 Worker Types), SEWB staff (1 Worker Type)

Ccare - Client contacts - Health professionals not recognised: Transport health professionals who do not work for the service, SEWB staff (2 Worker Types)

MD - Client contacts - Health professionals not recognised: Other Health / Clinical Staff, Specialist Other, SEWB Staff Other, Allied Health Other (4 Worker Types)

MMEx - Two contacts occurring on the same day with the same provider are counted as one client contact
